As we've looked over the past few days I pray you would have been comforted and reminded of your responsibility and role in your family. Today I want to move on just a bit and talk about your children, today once again we will find ourselves in a situation where God's word gives us the good way, the right way, the only way to success versus the way of the world, the wrong way, and the way to destruction and damnation. I would remind you that the Lord God Jehovah and this world are opposites and only one can grant you eternal life, only one is right, and trying to serve both is to serve the evil of the world. Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. (James Chapter 4 verse 4 KJV) – therefore put away the sayings and worldly wisdom for they have and will continue to fail you and lead you astray. Trust instead in the wisdom of the Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Word of God, with Him as your guide you will still have fights and struggles but you will have chosen the only path to eternal life and victory!

My purpose today is not to talk about the role of children in your life yet your role in the life of your children. What is your role? All we must do to understand our role in our children's life is to look at the role of God in ours, after all He is our Father, our Abba, and our greatest example of our calling. As we talk about our roles in our children's life let me begin by saying, do you let your children divide you? Do your children play you one off another? Do your children come and ask you something only to find later your spouse gave a different answer? How can you be divided? How can you possibly hope to stand against darkness and evil if you cannot stand firm together? Does not the word say: And Jesus knew their thoughts. and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand (Matthew Chapter 12 verse 25 **KJV)** – now the thing of which Jesus spoke was much different than I speak today but the point is the same, a house divided, a family divided, a marriage divided, parents divided cannot stand! You must remember what we are fighting for, the amount of drug use and alcohol abuse by young teenagers, teen pregnancy, teen murder, high school drop out rates, suicide rates, all the most terrible statistics are booming in our children... why? We refuse to accept God's plan and think we know better.

As parents it is our duty to be the provider for our children but not the "giver", God does not give us all "our hearts desires". Yet God gives us what we need: Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? (Matthew Chapter 6 verse 30 KJV) - let me be clear, spoiling our children can easily slip in to trying to replace love and attention with things... our Father in heaven does not give us our every heart's desire because would we pay attention to Him after that? If God gave us everything we ever dreamed of... we would replace Him with things... it is our duty to our children to provide all of what they need and if able and they EARN to give them some of what they want. SOME OF WHAT THEY WANT. What in the world could possibly be wrong with giving your children everything they want if you are blessed with the ability? Honour thy father and thy mother, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee; that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

(Deuteronomy Chapter 5 verse 16 KJV) – giving your children everything they ask for is a slippery slope. Have your children earned it? No? As a modern society we reward those who do nothing with something... we teach our children by our habits that "its OK, you tried" knowing they didn't really try... we feel guilty... so we give. We handicap our children by doing this thing. Knowing full well the word tells us about those who refuse to work for what they need and desire: For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat. (2 Thessalonians Chapter 3 verse 10 KJV).

Once we begin to understand that you must have a united front with your spouse, once you begin to understand it is your role to be the "provider" not the "giver", once you begin to understand God is our greatest example of what we should be like to our children you move on to the hard part: discipline. In today's "21st century" if you whip you children you have abused them... the cops may get called and the world looks on you like your a monster. When children have done wrong and you have corrected them it is vital to teach them the actions have real, sometimes very painful consequences. Why is it important? Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him. (Proverbs Chapter 22 verse 15 KJV) - our children don't understand nor should we assume they should the their actions have real, life altering consequences. And because we don't show them that their "foolishness" or ignorance has real consequences children murder one another... children think its OK to beat those they don't like, they come to schools with weapons and murder those they feel like have caused them pain... they turn to drugs, to alcohol, to cults, to sex... can you not see the problem? The world says "don't whip your children its not good for them" and we see the awful reality of the modern world as parents are asleep at the wheel. God says "but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him" knowing full well that if you teach your children everyday... they will listen and learn!

"I can't do it Daniel, I just can't do it", do you love your children? It is your role to discipline them. We've read it already but perhaps again: As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. (Revelation Chapter 3 verse 19 KJV) – Jesus Christ makes clear... those that He loves He disciplines! He teaches! In fact not to discipline your children is to hate them: He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes. (Proverbs Chapter 13 verse 24 KJV) – why? How could you possibly hate your child but not disciplining them? You are teaching them that it is OK to do the things they do... you are showing them that it is OK to act that way, that people will yell or put them in the "corner" but they can come right back out. Please don't misunderstand and this is important, beating your children is not OK. Whipping your children is not only OK but vital to their spiritual and mental health. You do it out of love, not anger. You do it calmly after explaining your decision and you stand by it! It is your role to be the disciplinary in the home! Whose role is it? The dad? The mother? BOTH! You are a UNITED front against the foolishness of your children!

As you enter into day 11 I would have you ponder, are you helping our hurting your children? By being a weak parent and letting them run all over you and putting you against your spouse you are crippling them and destroying the trust and relationship with your spouse. Ponder God's plan for you as a parent, be the provider of teaching, wisdom, and needs. You are not your child's "friend" you are their parent. Bring them up in the ways of the Lord and always remember: **Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. (Proverbs Chapter 22 verse 6 KJV).** 

Meet the family  We will soon be hearing from the second family in the "meet the family" section and I pray that you would ponder in your heart God's vision for your own family. Think to yourself today, what has God done in my life? What has He done in the lives of my family? Praise Him and thank Him for every blessing and every second that He has always been by your side! Amen.
