Food for thought

As we have talked about over the past three days we have established the basic role of the husband, of the wife, and of the parents of children as we have discovered just the surface of God's plan for you and your family. As we have discussed the past three days the truths we are looking upon are not the "world's accepted truths" but the Biblical, eternal, God given truths that are above all things, that were, are, and will always be the ONLY way, truth, and life that we all desperately seek. We have discussed again and again that fighting against God's plan is one of the greatest sources of our pain and suffering, it is only when we accept God and His plan for our life that we begin to pray not against it but simply that "His will be done", this should come as no surprise... Jesus Christ Himself commanded us: After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. (Matthew Chapter 6 verse 9-10 KJV) - which is to say "your will be done Lord in my life as it is in heaven", His will is His word, His word is true, it is eternal, and it is sufficient for all of life's questions and needs.

As we have discussed the role of the man of the house, the woman of the house, and the man and woman in relation to their children we must also focus on the relationship between the man and woman. We already know that husbands are called to love their wives as Christ loved the church, we already know that women are called to submit to their husbands as he is the head of the home. We already know that when men are fulfilling the God given command that women will have no problem doing so as well. When both the husband and wife are doing as God has commanded then the children will follow as the Godly parents obey God's command to discipline and love their children, to bring them up in His ways, and to allow God to move freely and with power over the home. Today we are going to talk about the relationship between husband and wife, I know writing this even now that this is a hard issue and thus I will be straight forward as possible but I pray God would open your heart and soul to His truth.

Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband. The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife. Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency. But I speak this by permission, and not of commandment. (1 Corinthians Chapter 7 verse 3-6 KJV) – intimacy... it is a demonstration of your closeness to your spouse, it is the most physical way of demonstrating your love and relationship to your husband or wife. Countless marriages have been destroyed by temptation and destruction of affairs, pornographic addictions, unseemly obsessions, and unbiblical expectations. Let me be very clear here, husbands your body does not belong to you, it is your wife's. Wives your body does not belong to you, it is your husbands... what I am saying is simply what the Apostle Paul said not as a commandment but purely a strong suggestion, do not deny one another. Sex is not a weapon, intimacy is not be denied. Sex is not simply for procreation, God has created us as couples to share our bodies with OUR SPOUSE. Are you cheating on vour spouse? Are you sure?

But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart. (Matthew Chapter 5 verse 28 KJV) – stop justifying it. Stop trying to explain it away. Face it. The truth is that the ONLY person we are to experience a sexual relationship with is our spouse, we are to do so out of our love and our understanding that we all have needs we must fulfill and we must do it in a Christ honoring, loving, wonderful way as we show our emotional, spiritual love through our physical abilities. Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency. - men and women are carnal creatures, our carnal needs are genuine physical needs. Those who are withholding intimacy from their spouse, those who are using it as a weapon, those who continue to put themselves before their spouse... why? Why deny your spouse knowing full well their desperate desire to have a healthy need for YOU. When a spouse longs for their spouse and longs to express love in the most intimate way how could you knowingly deny your spouse?

"Its my body" again and again I see the way the world's way has worked out. 50% of marriages in America end in divorce... porn addicts hide in their basements so helpless with a powerful addiction that is beyond your understanding until you find yourself there. Men and women lusting after all sorts of unseemly and sinful things... we have forgotten that our bodies are not ours... our bodies are our spouses, and we are called not to deny them but to embrace them. Talk about it! Share your expectations and problems with your spouse! Be honest! Face it together! I want you to understand something, it is NEVER OK to force your spouse to do anything. I have heard it said that a man cannot rape his wife for it is her duty. I say yes he can. A man and woman are called, not demanded to give their affections to their spouse. We do it out of our command to love each other and submit to each other as we become one flesh because we know God's plan is better than our plan. Please know that if your wife denies you, if your husband denies you, this is no just cause for divorce, this is no just cause for an affair, this is no just cause for fornication and immorality. Do you not know that it is written: Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind (1 Corinthians Chapter 6 verse 9 KJV).

I leave you with this, on day 12 of the 30 day challenge ponder and ask yourself: am I giving all I have to give? Am I doing my very best? Am I doing everything I can? I promise you as I know from experience, when you stop forcing the issue, when you pray, sacrifice your happiness for that of your spouse, love your spouse as Christ loved the church, submit to your spouse, and become willing to give up everything for them... they will willingly give up everything for you! Lead by example, show your love through actions, never forgetting that actions speak louder than words. It is not your "right" as I once thought it was to have sex with your spouse, but something that is given out of love. You must do all that you can do to grow close to your spouse, do everything you can possibly do to be open, honest, and Biblical about your relationship. Trust God's way, His way is so much better and leads to eternal life and joy, the path to destruction is easier but leads to destruction... God's way is the right way. Husband give everything for your wife, love her as Christ loved the church, wife give everything for your husband, love Him as Christ loved the church. Submit one to another knowing the scripture is clear: Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband. (1 Corinthians Chapter 7 verse 2 KJV).

Meet the family We will soon be hearing from the second family in the "meet the family" section and I pray that you would ponder in your heart God's vision for your own family. Think to yourself today, what has God done in my life? What has He done in the lives of my family? Praise Him and thank Him for every blessing and every second that He has always been by your side! Amen.

Prayer Suggestions

Today before you pray I would like you to understand the beautiful promise the Lord gives us about our prayer: Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. (Matthew Chapter 7 verse 7-8 KJV) – today God is giving you the opportunity to demonstrate His power and grace... while you take it? Bow your head, humble yourself before Him, open your heart and your mouth in prayer!

Today pray for:

- That God would give you victory over sexual immorality and free you from any ungodly vice
- That God would convict your heart of any darkness and drive it away with the Holy Spirit
- That God would heal your intimate life with your spouse and bless you to experience true love and joy with your spouse
- That God would bring you closer through honesty and love with your spouse and touch your marriage
- That God would remind you that His way is the right way and lead you down the straight and narrow
