As we continue to discover the foundation of the family we have observed God's plan for us as husband, as wife, as husband and wife, as parents, and only scratching the surface I pray that you would have a better understanding as you seek to know God more, as you seek to honor Him with your prayers, obedience, love, and faith. As you walk in faith the last thing that we must look at in our foundation is perhaps the greatest: love. Love in our homes is the best example of a Godly home. Love between husband and wife, love between father and children, love between mother and children, our love is the greatest example of what we believe about Christ and His way and truth for our lives. Love is such an important characteristic of a Godly home that it is described this way: And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these. (Mark Chapter 12 verse 31 KJV). Love is not just a word, it is not just a feeling, it is an action, showing love is making sure your actions speak louder than words! Love is more than a kiss, love is more than holding hands, love is every look, every thought, every action, every prayer, we must love in our homes as Christ loved the church!

A brother in Christ once told a story of how some women saw a man buying flowers for his wife at the store and thought "I would love a husband like that" and as the man got home he gave his wife flowers hoping she wouldn't go to the cops about last night when he beat her... looks can be deceiving from the outside but God knows our heart, our family knows our heart, we may say all the right things, do the right things, and pretend perfectly in public and at church pretending to be the perfect family but we serve a God who knows not only what we do in the open, but also in secret. But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly. (Matthew Chapter 6 verse 6 KJV). Knowing that God sees and knows all things why in the world would you ever waste the effort trying to fake it? True love is a dad stepping in front of a bullet for his children, true love is a husband pushing his wife out of the way of a speeding car, true love is the God of the universe dying on a cross not calling down legions of angels to destroy the world. What love God must feel for us to die for us!? As Christ Himself wonderfully told us: Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. (John Chapter 15 verse 13 KJV).

As you enter in to day 14 of the 30 day challenge I am curious, are you loving your family like you are commanded? When is the last time your spouse desperately wanted something you couldn't give them and you hurt in that? When is the last time that you would give anything to give them what they desired? When is the last time you put their needs above yours? Is this not what we are called to do? For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. (Ephesians Chapter 5 verse 23 KJV) – How did Christ love the church? He loved the church so much, He so desperately cared for the body that He put our peace and eternal life above His own. Did Jesus Christ have to die on the cross? No. Jesus Christ the living God, the Almighty, the Holy Lamb, the King of Kings could have called down His angels to save Him from the hands that killed Him... but He didn't, why? For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting

life. (John Chapter 3 verse 16 KJV) – love... He loved us as His sons and daughters and knew that if He didn't lay down His life that there would be no other way for us to come to Him! What can you learn as a parent, as a spouse from that? Sacrifice everything for those you love...

As you have completed this week you have read about the relationship between husband and wife, between parents and children, we have covered so much... if from this program you don't take a single thing except this I pray you would pay attention: love conquers fear and hate. Through our love in Christ knowing the pain and price He paid for us, knowing His command for us to forgive all transgressions of those who have hurt us, knowing that we must love like Jesus. Jesus Christ is love, we must first seek to love the Lord our god with all our heart, soul, and strength for this is the greatest commandment, then we must pour out this same love abundantly upon our families! How is the love in your home? Isn't it time to make a change? What could get better? How could you more fully fulfill your role? How could you be a better servant of Christ? How can you be a better light for Christ? How can you grow and allow Jesus to heal your family? As you enter in to day 14 I pray you would ponder these questions and search the scripture and the Almighty God in prayer for these answers! Pour out your love even through the pain and hardship that the Holy Spirit may move in your family always! Amen.
