It is so easy to say "I give up" or "I quit" and to walk away from some of life's most important opportunities, I wonder how many lives have been forever altered by the men and women who have forgotten: without a "test" there is no "testimony"! As you start today I pray you would do so knowing that God does not promise us we won't walk through the valley, God does not promise us we will not face the fire... God only promises that He will never leave our side! He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God. (Daniel Chapter 3 verse 25 KJV) — as you enter in today I want you to remember that even when we face the fire that Jesus Christ is with us! I want you to remind yourself all day today that regardless of what happens you will bring God glory, you will trust Him, and you will know that His plan for you is wonderful. God has given you a special person to walk through all of life's fires with that you can see, you can touch, you can talk to, you can cry with, you can laugh with, today look at your spouse and search them, why did you fall in love? Why did you say "I do"? Today do something unexpected for them knowing that even in the pain and suffering that you do still love them.

Today as you think about your marriage and what God has in store for it, remembering yesterday the food for thought was that God is in control and He has a wonderful plan in store for you, remember to see Him out, seek out His desire, seek out His will, seek out His plan. You must remember that we are sinful, short sighted, wrong, failing people and even when we try our best, even when we fight our hardest, if we don't fight with Christ in our hearts and God on our minds we will fail. We must trust in the Lord and we must seek Him out, the scripture teaches us: And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart. (Jeremiah Chapter 29 verse 13 KJV). Today as you enter into prayer for yourself, for your spouse, and for your family I trust you will do it knowing that we all need God and that His hands can and will heal all things if you would only place your trust in Him. It does my heart good to know that God always walks by our sides, that He has a wonderful plan in place for us, and that if we seek Him with all our heart... we will find Him!
