What is the most important thing in your life? When you close your eyes and think about it... what is the one thing you can't live without? What is the one thing that daily you seek and desire to have? What is the one thing that you put above all others? As you enter day 27 of the 30 day challenge I pray you would examine your heart and truly understand, that one thing must be our relationship with Jesus Christ. Putting Christ at the center and making Him the first priority in our lives is not easy but is eternally rewarding. Everyday we must make a conscious choice to follow the Lord with all of our heart, all of our strength, and all of our mind, for this is the first and greatest commandment: And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this is the first commandment. (Mark Chapter 12 verse 30 KJV).

Where is God in your list of things to do? If you thought about putting God first in your life, if you thought of the things someone who obeys the Lord and puts Him above all things and loves Him above all things what kind of relationship do you think they might have? Would they pray? Without ceasing. Would they seek to know Him more? Everyday. Would they share the love with those around them? All the time. Would they obey His commands?
