Today we are begging a new journey, over the next week we are going to learn about "the foundation" and while this may be a refresher for some of you I pray that you would all take the time to ponder on this guick message. What is the foundation? The foundation in our relationship with Christ is the confession that we made, to see the beauty of the foundation we only need to look at the words of our Lord and savior: When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am? And they said, Some say that thou art John the Baptist: some, Elias: and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. He saith unto them, But whom say ve that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven. And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. - Jesus Christ was not telling Peter that "he was a rock" yet that the confession of Jesus as Christ was the rock, the confession, and upon that confession He would build His church... and hell shall not overcome it or prevail against it! As you begin today I pray you would search your heart, do you know Jesus Christ? Notice my question was not "do you know OF Jesus Christ" yet my question is do you PERSONALLY know Jesus Christ? Have you accepted Him? Have you confessed Him? Have you trusted in Him? Do you love Him? Do you follow Him?

"Today I am unhappy, I hear how great things can be but I'm not so sure about whats going on in my life right now. I just want to be happy, so whats wrong with that? Just wanting to be happy, everybody deserves happiness don't they? I'm not so sure anymore... what needs to happen so I to can be happy? I'm just so confused about everything in my life, in the world, and in the universe. For starters I try and try to make my loved ones happy but it never seems to work. I've been trying to control my temper but it is much harder than I thought it was going to be. I feel so alone, people are all around me yes... but not that kind of alone... alone in my heart."

"Today I'm going to try to make it as simple as I can. Try to do everything in my power to make Kimberly my love, my heart, my soul, happy and make sure she comes first."

"I'm so lost I don't know what to do anymore. (Genesis Chapter 2 verse 24 KJV) - to become one flesh as we will examine later on through the program is a physical alteration that to reverse would be a mutilation and a physical destruction of ones own flesh and is the furthest thing from God's desire for any family. It is our dearest hope that God will reveal His glory and that Jesus Christ will pour out His grace upon all those who participate in this program regardless of the purpose. The truth is that Jesus Christ is not "a hope" He is the ONLY HOPE and the only way for families to make it through the stress and destruction of today's society is through keeping Him always at the center.
