Food for thought

Have you ever asked yourself how is it that the Bible, the Word of God, is so perfect and reads like such a thriller from Genesis to Revelation that it seems as if the same person wrote it? The Bible is unique from any other book or collection of books in a way that reveals such a powerful truth that many men and women spend their entire life fighting it and trying to disprove it only understanding that much later that it can't be disproved, it can't be undone, it can't be explained away, and the powerful truth is greater than any thing man could ever have done alone. The word Bible actually means "collection of books", it has 40 authors, some where kings, some where fishermen, shepherds, priest, and prophets. The Bible was written in 3 different languages, on 3 different continents, in times of war and in days of peace. It is sufficient for all of life's questions, it gives us the perfect picture of our God and the mercy and love that He has for us. Why are so many people afraid to admit that the Bible is something special? I suspect it is simply that if they admit the Bible is something greater than a collection of books they would have to examine their lives and begin to ask themselves some very hard questions... if the Bible is the Word of God which we know that it is... then everything it contains must be true? It is, and because it is I pray you would understand Bible study is critical to our walk with the Lord and bringing us closer to the peace and mercy we seek!

For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. (Hebrews Chapter 4 verse 12 KJV) – if we do not surrender to the power which is the Word, which the Word is Jesus Christ then how can we hope to know our God? How can we hope to know His call on our lives? I can call myself a lawyer all day long but unless I studied hard and know the letter of the law I won't be very good in fighting for a client... just as you study to be great in school or at work you must learn about God! You must seek Him out in His word, you must know who, what, why, and how you are to serve the mighty Jehovah and His word and prayer go hand-in-hand!

Do you know that you have power? Do you know that Jesus Christ died not only to give us freedom, mercy, and grace, but also through His death and as we are given the Holy Spirit as we discussed yesterday we are given a direct channel to speak to God. When have you go on your knees and really just poured out your heart? The scripture teaches us: **Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. (Philippians Chapter 4 verse 6 KJV) – again and again we are taught that prayer is a must! God reveals to me His desire and the actions He would have me do through prayer. When I pray and trust God I make good, God honoring, God conscience decisions... when I don't pray and trust God? I fail. I make commitments that I struggle to keep, I make poor choices that lead to failure and pain! When is the last time you not only poured out your heart to God but listened to His response? When you hear that voice in your mind saying "don't do that" or "please stop what your doing" do you aquate that to your "conscience" or as a born again Child of God is that the Holy Spirit crying out for us to walk in God's statues? As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. (Revelation Chapter 3 verse 19 KJV) – as you enter into**

day 5 of the 30 day challenge I pray you would do three things: 1. Examine your prayer life and habits, do you only pray to God when you need something? Aren't you truly always in need of something? Know that God wants you to talk to Him daily, wake up talking to Him, talk to Him relentlessly all day, tell Him good night! Prayer is our greatest power as Christians and Christ died to give us the ability to speak to Him without a priest or anyone else. 2. Examine your study habits. This is the greatest test we will ever endure, how in the world can you ever hope to pass the test if you don't know the course material? Shouldn't you be studying like your life depended on it? In the case it does! Get in the word and seek out God's desire and plan for your life. 3. Accept the rebuke of the Lord. No one likes being told their wrong, especially when you are really really wrong. Sin is sin, trust God when He corrects you and don't continue to sin against Him. Sinning against God over and over again will grieve the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit will leave you, repent of your sin and walk faithfully determined to honor and glorify the Lord in all you do!

Meet the family

Last time we heard from our brother in Christ Jason and how the Lord loved him even before Jason knew Him as Lord and savior. When we last left Jason he shared his thought "without God's love in my life nothing is possible" and as we continue tonight I pray would understand how Jason, how his wife Kimberly, and how every born again child of God comes to that truth: experience. Tonight we pickup where we last left off with brother Jason.

"I never was a good kid and neither of my parents were Christian church going people. I took after them in their ways of doing drugs, lying and cheating and thought that's the way life is supposed to be. My mom and dad divorced when I was young and their marriages they had when growing up was no way to lead my life, but I didn't know that then."

"So I got married the 1st time and was a cheater. I lied, cheated and stole all through my marriage. I didn't know the meaning of being faithful. I cheated with anyone and everyone I could and rubbed it in my wife's face. At the age of 21 I had a heart attack and almost died. The doctors could not explain or figure out why I was having heart attacks and complete blockages, on my 22nd birthday I had to have bypass open heart surgery. The doctors where stumped, they didn't know what was wrong or how to fix it. The bypass blocked back off. I had a daughter with my 1st wife and it didn't change who I was or the way I treated my wife. And I continued to have heart problems, I didn't know it then but God had some work he wanted me to do."

Tonight as you read through brother Jason's testimony I challenge you to examine the circumstances. Already you have seen that God has impacted this brothers life in a powerful, unbelievable way and I pray as you learn more about his testimony you would understand: God can save anyone and everyone. Tonight I pray you would begin to realize as brother Jason now knows, God has a plan for you, He has something wonderful in store for your life and your marriage if you would only trust in Him. Tonight as you ponder about Jason's testimony I pray you would do so knowing that God's plan may take you through dark valleys and pain but when you come out on the other side the blessings and faithfulness of God is beyond your wildest dream! Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee... (Jeremiah Chapter 1 verse 5 KJV) – if you are reading through Jason's testimony today and you feel the Lord pulling on your heart... answer His call! You will be eternally glad you did!
