I realize now without God's love I couldn't truly know how to love anyone including myself. I had to pray for God to show me how to truly love and now that He has I know anything is possible. And my marriage can make it through anything with God's grace. I'm not as good as I want to be but I'm better than I once was!"

Sister Kim's conclusion in testimony

"My biggest issue in my marriage is trust. To give up control and let some one have the power to hurt you. Would you close your eyes and fall backwards and know that you will always be caught? To be honest I came into this marriage already bruised from falling to many times and nobody catching me. It kinda feels like in the back of my mind (and heart) that I'm always waiting for my next fall and bruise. I have a very controlling and needy personality. Not a good combination. I married Jason expecting him to fail me. I looked for ways to provide to myself that I and all the women in my life were right. That men sucked. They will use you, beat you, cheat on you, and leave you. I twas like I had a pre-made check list and always had my pen ready to check off my list. So for years I saw suspicion in everything that Jason did. I checked and rechecked caller ids. I listened to voice mail and thought to death about every single word and what was said and unsaid. I checked call times and how long they took. And I became the queen on questions and doubt."

"I would leave work early to try and catch Jason doing something. Anything. I would call him over and over. I would listen to background noise. And when Jason got a phone with a camera and internet I could have chewed nails in two. I worried constantly. When I met Jason he had a routine already setup where he and his daughter spent every weekend with his brother. His brother had a new wife who had 2 very beautiful teenage daughters. And I had a crush on Jason. She loved to be on Jason's 4 wheeler, her mom wouldn't let the girls ride alone. In Ellijay where they would go on a ride it would kill me. Inside me lives another me that is crazy. And my other me can find fault in anything. Did I know if anything was happening on these trips? No. But I expected it to. I did everything I could to keep us from going there."

To keep us from spending the night. So I wasn't surprised when Jason told me something happened, because I already knew it was going to happen. I was waiting on it.

Then in my mind and heart I had to justify what happened. How much will I put up with before I leave him. Does one kiss end a relationship? Does the good still out weight the bad? And do you believe him? Did she start it and he responded? How much really happened? I wasn't there. Life moves on and I got over it and we stayed together. But I watched even closer now."

"Me and Jason move around a lot. We settle for awhile in Jasper and my mom moved in with us. Jason got a job at a cabinet shop and only worked with 6 or 7 other men. I think I was in heaven. Then they hired one women to answer the phone and work in the office. At first I was OK with her working there, well kind of anyway. I still had that voice in my head you know, the other me, that's crazy. And then it was time to go to a office party and I got to meet her. She was cute, small and petite, everything that I am not. I thought I saw her flirting with Jason, but no way, I mean out of the 7 or so men that work here she couldn't really be interested in mine. But yes she was... so to forgive again, but never to forget. Years went by and we moved again to Adairsville. By this time we had fought over everything under the sun. Some fights were getting violent on both sides. Does the good still out weight the bad? Now we had a miracle baby and we know he is miracle. But we still hadn't given our lives over to God."

"With-in walking distance Jason had found a church he liked and started going without me. So I went with him, Jason turned his life and soul over to God and confessed his sins to me and God, he pleaded with us both to love him and forgive him. It seemed to me that he might be telling the truth this time and by now I had also given my life to God. So we worked it out and made it work. Two days ago my crazy self thought Jason was getting to friendly with the neighbor. We fought,s creamed, punched things and go the local police called. Luckily by God's grace neither of us went to jail but not from lack of trying on our parts. So I packed my baby, my mom, and myself and left."

"I thought for ever after... but God knew better and brought us home the same day, just much later. We talked it through and we are still trying. Everyday is a struggle. Being married happily is the hardest thing I have ever done. I get in my own way a lot. But God always saves me. And always brings me and Jason back together."

I pray that as you read through both the testimony of this brother and sister you would know that their marriage is not perfect, far from it, but their marriage is real. Their marriage is what none of us want to admit ours is, a fight, a struggle, a war, a war against each other, a war against God, a war against satan, a war against darkness and evil. In this war their will be ups, their will be downs, it is not how we fall but where we land that makes all the difference. Tonight I pray you would understand that God is not a one stop solution to your problems, Jesus Christ is not a magic fix for all life's worries, He is the begging of healing, and if you have faith and stick to your walk with the Lord you will find forgiveness and healing that you could never imagine... God has demonstrated it in my marriage, in the marriage of Kim and Jason, and millions of marriages around the world that have found the scripture is beautiful and true: Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. (2 Corinthians Chapter 5 verse 16 KJV)

Prayer Suggestions

Today before you pray I would like you to understand the beautiful promise the Lord gives us about our prayer: Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.
