#### One Flesh

and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'? So they are no longer two but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man separate." (Matthew 19:5,6)

On April 26, 2003, Aron Lee Ralston was hiking in Utah's Bluejohn Canyon. During the hike, Ralston found himself trapped after an 800 lb bolder shifted, and pinned his right hand to the canyon wall. Ralston had not told anybody of his hiking plans, thus no one would be searching for him. After six days of entrapment and with dehydration setting in, he knew the only way of escape was to amputate his own right hand. Using a dull multi-tool, he was able free himself from a dislodged boulder. When God joins a couple together, they are to become one flesh. In order for a separation to happen, an amputation must take place. Divorce may happen, but every avenue of survival should first be exhausted. I can't even comprehend how difficult of a decision that must have been for Ralston to make, but it should be just as difficult for us to leave the person God has joined us with. Today make a commitment to each other and God that separation will only be an option after every possible means of survival has been explored.

## Food for thought

Over the next 7 days we are going to talk about the role and responsibilities of the family. We are going to discuss some things that are not necessarily what the world wants to hear. We are going to discuss the truth but before we do I need you to examine your own heart, ponder this scripture: Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. (James Chapter 4 verse 4 KJV) – it is important to know that we may not always be able to easily understand God's purpose and plan but He is ALWAYS right, and anyone who disagrees with His word, His commands, and His law is WRONG. I know how it feels knowing sometimes that we can't understand why God does or doesn't allow things but it is not always for us to understand. Trust instead not in this world but in God, trust in His word, and cry out to Him in prayer as you don't fully understand that the Holy Spirit may give you discernment. To be with this world is to be against God, remember that as we move through this week.

Over the past few years it has become more and more mainstream to say "it doesn't matter who you marry just as long as your happy" and while it sounds good it is absolutely a abomination. Marriage is an institution designed to be shared between ONE MAN and ONE WOMAN and as such we must establish our foundation on this truth. Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. (Genesis Chapter 2 verse 24 KJV) - it is important to know several things, first God has called man to leave his family and to "cleave" and become one flesh with his wife. Never anywhere in the Bible is it acceptable for a man and a man to be together, or a woman and a woman together, homosexuality is an abomination to God and regardless of our feelings about the subject God is perfectly clear: Thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with womankind: it is abomination. (Leviticus Chapter 18 verse 22 KJV) - an abomination that is something "that is hated or disgusting" and thus we know that marriage is intended to be between one man and one woman. Once we understand this I need you to know that God DOES NOT hate sinners, God DOES hate sin... sin is sin, all sin is sin before God, it separates us from Him and thus it is vital that we repent of our sins and draw close to God.

Once we have established in our hearts God's definition of marriage being between one man and one woman it is important to look at Genesis 2:24 again Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. We are not called to call our mom or dad and pour out all our dirty laundry about our marriage, we are called to "leave" our father and mother, our marriage should be between us and God, no one else. If we must bring an outside party into our marriage it should be a pastor, deacon, or someone who is dedicated to the Lord and will hear BOTH of you and give you a Bible based, scriptural answer. By bringing outside friends and family into a disagreement or hurt we allow the devil to get at us from multiple directions. Bringing ungodly people in to give us advice about how to live a God honoring, Christ centered marriage is a serious problem that has lead to many divorces because of bad advice and the stoking of flames.

As you enter into day 8 of the 30 day challenge I pray you would realize first and most

importantly the Bible must be the final authority on all matters of faith, practice, and living in your life. You must study, pray, and trust in God's leadership in all matters. God's word covers all questions in life and is sufficient to answer anything you may need to know. We must understand that God is ALWAYS right and we are ONLY right when we TRUST in HIS WORD! We are ALWAYS WRONG when we disagree with God's word, we may not understand it but we must accept it as correct even when the world hates it and cannot understand. Lastly we must surround our marriage not with ravenous wolves who claim to be friends who will give us ungodly advice and lead us astray in our times of need but we must surround our marriages with Christ honoring brothers and sisters who will never tell us to surrender or walk away. We must leave our family out of our marriage and our problems because I guarantee you it will cause more hurt than healing.
