Week 3 – Each day is getting better!

We are referred to as the “bride of Christ” throughout the New Testament and that reference gives us many truths we must understand, embrace, and seek each day in our lives with the Lord. As any relationship we must seek to know the Lord more, we must set aside special time for Him, we have a desperate desire to know Him, to feel Him, and to understand His desires for our life. As you enter day 16 of the 365 day devotion I wonder, what is keeping you from a full

relationship with the Lord? God is the Alpha and the Omega, the unchangeable eternal God who is, was, and always will be... if He is always the same, what's changed?
