





Week 4 – walk an inch He'll take you a mile

Our enemy is very real, the devil seeks to consume you, he seeks to destroy you and it is by God's mercies that we are not consumed! I have found more struggle and more battle since I started to fight for my Christ than I ever knew before... why? Its not easy! The cross gets heavy! The burden gets more than I could ever

bare, alone, but I'm not alone! As you enter day 24 of the 365 day devotion I wonder, do you feel alone? God has made the promise that He will never leave nor forsake us! Trust in the promise of Christ "I am with you always!" Not just in good times but "til the end of the earth' (Matthew 24:20).
