Grab your sword, grab your armor, to battle we go!

Now you even take your sword with you when...you take care of business.

The Armor of God

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. 11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. 13 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. 14 Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, 15 and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. 16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

45 David said to the Philistine, “You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the LORD Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. (1 Samuel Chapter 17 verse 45 NIV)

It is often hard to believe the power of the Lord because his power is above the understanding of anyone of us! The thought that the Lord created the earth and the heavens just by speaking them into existence seems impossible, but again God is not a man. God created man. God created all things. This weeks life impacting scripture is to remind everyone that regardless of our fear or the situation that the Lord will always prevail!

The story of David and Goliath is perhaps one of the best known Bible stories but people tend to forget the significance of this story. First David a child, a shepherd, someone who had never been to war versus Goliath, a veteran warrior who was huge, who was so frightening that the entire army of the Lord was to afraid to fight him even as he hurled insults against not only them but God. The Lord sent David into a very quick battle with Goliath in which the veteran warrior of an opposing army that was challenging the Lord was quickly killed and the opposing army was totally defeated.

Why is this story important? First, the Lord is not bound by our understanding, His power is unbeatable and his wisdom and knowledge eternal and always correct. Second, the Lord uses those who are the lowest, the “weakest”, the youngest, the most foolish to humble those who are kings, those who are strong, and those who are old and wise. The Lord is not burdened by our understanding and He is not limited to what we think He can or cannot do! The Lord is the master of the universe and He has power over all things!

Know that when you are praying that you pray to a God who hears your prayers! A God that loves you so much he sent His Son Jesus Christ to die for you! A God that is in need of absolutely nothing! A God that is jealous and wants a relationship with the soul He caused to dwell in us! Know that your prayers are known before you pray them! That they will be answered as you pray them! That the Lord is the truth, He is the light, He is holy, He is perfect and that if your prayer is for something you are truly in need of the Lord will answer the prayer always in time!

Always remember and never forget the Lord can do all things and that if the Lord is truly with someone it doesn't matter who or what stands against them, the Lord prevails! Praise you mighty Father!
