A Time Limit On God

You may have heard your pastor say on occasion, Ill have you out in just a minute, give me a few more minutes. People get restless, the congregation gets hungry and we have stuff we gotta do! Shopping and getting ready for the week is more important then church?!

Revelation 3:15-16 KJV

15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. 16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Do you think the Holy Spirit, the Almighty, The passion of God, the Creator of the universe can be forced? Can be timed? Can be controlled by us carnal earthly sinful people? The Spirit is a gentleman and will not be forced, he will not be where he is not wanted and he will not be timed.

God leads us, not the other way around. We cannot lead God, we ask to receive, not tell, and we will not, CAN NOT force God. Love is for us not against us. Let God lead you, for he knows best

6He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved. 7In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God. 8Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah. (Psalm Chapter 62 verse 6-8 KJV)

As I have read through the book of Psalms I keep thinking to myself how King David would be a man I would like to meet. The times when He cries out to God, when He reaffirms the truth that God is the rock of salvation, that God is the strong tower, the place of refuge and protection from the enemies in life I am both comforted in knowing that a man God calls "a man after His own heart" could struggle and that I serve a God that used this man, protected this man, and blessed this man powerfully! King David is perhaps one of the greatest men in Biblical history, in the top 5 of a very short list of men and Christ Himself who have made the greatest impact on history of the Hebrew race. I want you to think about it tonight, are you hurting? Are you weary? Are you burdened and in such pain you don't know what to do? Even the strongest, most mighty, most powerful king, filled with the Holy Spirit and lead by God was scared... was beaten... was hurt... was shamed... was weary... and yet? He trusted in God!

Tonight I want to remind you that God should be the place where we turn when we are in need, He should also be the God we turn to to praise in times of peace and success but we tend to forget that men don't make it alright, God does! We seem to forget that the hands and the words of men and women are nothing compared to the God of creator who beautifully promises never to forsake or leave us! Through our relationship with Jesus Christ we have a direct link to God, we do not need men, we do not need anything else but our knees and our faith. Prayer and trust in God in the troubling valleys will see to it that as our brother King David boldly proclaimed "I shall not be moved" that in our faith the rock of our salvation Jesus Christ will not move even one inch. He will compel is forward, serving Him through faith and the power of the Holy Spirit we shall be bold and zealous for our king.

"Pour out your heart" did you know that God already knows your needs? He already knows your heartache and just what you want to say to Him! God knows! Have you ever seen the silly skit where the woman grabs the kid and says "momma knows child momma knows"? Its hard to remember that yes God is the creator of the universe but He is the tender, merciful, loving God who left His throne to die for us! I want to remind you that YES God will and does understand, pour out your heart, and even if you can't see how God will hear your prayer and will give you what you NEED not always what you WANT! Trust that God knows what you NEED and even if your heart can't see it that God always has your best interest in mind. He is a loving, sovereign, all knowing and all powerful Abba who is created us that we may know Him! Know Him that we may love Him! Love Him that we may want Him! Want Him that we may need Him! God WANTS a relationship with us just like we should DESPERATELY WANT a relationship with Him!

Tonight I challenge you, even if you don't regularly read your Bible... start reading just 1 Psalm a day. You will find that some of the greatest men in history struggled and wared with the enemy just as we are now! Trust in Jesus! Have faith in the Lord and pour out your heart to Him! He is waiting and wanting for you!! Amen.

It seems like since I've been working in ministry I have seen more pain, sorrow, and suffering than I ever knew existed. How wonderful that I have also been blessed to see so much love, mercy, and hope as I never saw before the Lord blessed me to begin walking faithful with Him. This week a brother in Christ contacted me with a need that caught me in the middle of a rock and a hard place... the need? Not anything to much or to great, he needed some help with food for his girlfriends mother, who turned out to be a 71 year old woman who had nothing to eat and none of the basic necessities we take for granted... the problem? I just happened to be tapped out financially and I was unable to get any help from my contacts in town. After calling pastors, churches, and ministries in town to no avail the power of the Lord demonstrated it self as it always does...

I need you to understand with me as I am humbled to know again and again, God's time is not our time, God as some would put it comes through "just in time" and sometimes we have to faithfully and diligentally work to resolve an issue through faith and it is only when we are exhausted and have started to give up that God roars forward as if to ask "why didn't you stay faithful"? After I had exhausted all my leads, understanding I was not financially able to provide, and knowing I didn't have much hope of getting what this woman needed a sister in Christ asked me "do you want me to post on Facebook about the need? I'm sure someone from the church I used to go to would help" and 20 minutes later a sister in Christ came forward and offered to help...

A few hours later the sister in Christ who had posted the message and her friend stepped forward were ministering to this woman, sharing the love and mercy of Christ! How beautiful knowing not only that this woman went to bed with a full stomach but it was after crying and being loved on by sisters who genuinely helped out of love and desire to serve Christ. So I want to remind you, just when it seems like "its always something" and you run out of resources and contacts... don't lose faith God will always provide! Never forget the truth: **28And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.** (Romans Chapter 8 verse 28 KJV).
